

Sunset Review Committee Banking Commission

May 21, 2024

Chairman Wilkin and members of the Sunset Review Committee, thank you for the opportunity to present information to you on the Ohio Banking Commission. My name is Matthew Green, and I am Division Counsel for the Division of Financial Institutions at the Ohio Department of Commerce.

The Banking Commission is responsible for making recommendations to the Division on matters pertinent to the business of Ohio-chartered banks, including matters relating to policy, statutory changes, and administrative rule changes. A major role of the Commission is to hear and consider the budget for the Banks Fund (which supports the Banks and Money Transmitters sections of the Division) and to confirm or deny assessment recommendations submitted by the superintendent.

The Commission is made up of nine members, including the Deputy Superintendent for Banks, who serves as the chairperson. The remaining members are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate, and they include bank executives and/or directors of Ohio banks. Members serve without compensation apart from reimbursement for travel expenses.

The Commission's workload remains relatively consistent since the most recent review. It holds quarterly meetings, and support for the Commission is provided by the Division.

In closing, the Department of Commerce respectfully requests that the Banking Commission be reauthorized.
