Agency's primary purpose and its various goals and objectives
The Small Business Advisory Council is tasked by ORC 107.63 with advising the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, and the Common Sense Initiative on the adverse impact the draft and existing rules might have on small businesses.
CSI consults with council members electronically on a biweekly basis regarding the adverse impact on business of regulations filed with CSI by various agencies, boards, and commissions.
