Agency's primary purpose and its various goals and objectives

The purpose of the Home Medical Equipment Services Advisory Council is to advise the Board of Pharmacy on issues relating to provision of home medical equipment services. The Council was developed to advise the Board on the regulation of Home Medical Equipment Services when such oversight was transferred to the Board as a result of HB 49 (132nd General Assembly - 2018).

The Council must consist of not more than seven individuals knowledgeable in the provision of home medical equipment services. Members shall serve three-year terms.

Agency's past and anticipated workload, number of staff required to complete workload, and total number of staff

The Council is coordinated by one Ohio Board of Pharmacy staff member, the Board's Policy and Public Affairs Liaison.

Agency's past and anticipated budgets and its sources of funding

Meetings are held in person and members are not compensated for their participation. The only costs associated with the Council are staff time to coordinate meetings. Therefore, the Board of Pharmacy utilizes licensing revenue to coordinate the Council.

There are 5 members of the Council and members are not compensated for their participation.
