Written Testimony – Jennifer Kline – Ohio Small Government Capital Improvements Commission

The Ohio Small Government Capital Improvements Commission approves grants and loans to villages and townships with populations in the unincorporated areas of less than 5,000 in population. Small Government Program capital funds are provided as a statutory 10% set-aside from the Ohio Public Works Commission's administered State Capital Improvement Program. The Small Government Commission is made up of 10 members of which the seven voting members are appointed by the seven voting members of the Ohio Public Works Commission. The Small Government Commission is responsible for affirming or overruling the project recommendations by the Administrator.
